What is A.C. Milan?

A.C. Milan is one of the world's most successful football teams and surely the most successful professional club in the last 25 years. In the last four years alone it has won its 7th Champions League Cup, 17th Italian League, 5th Italian Cup, 5th Italian Super Cup, 6th European Super Cup, 3rd Intercontinental Cup and 1st FIFA Club World Cup.

In 2012 A.C. Milan is striving for the Italian League Cup once again.

A.C. Milan is a winner on the field and is a pioneer in soccer management with its Milan Academy, a pioneer in giving back to the community through the Milan Foundation and a pioneer in soccer medicine through its Milan Lab. A.C. Milan is the world's first professional sports team to create its own laboratory for research of all aspects of the sport. Milan Lab is a major world breakthrough in modern sports medicine and has played a vital role in the team's incredible success in the five years.

A.C. Milan is also a leader in development of young talent with its Milan Junior Camps (MJC) in over 40 countries. Since 2005, over 50,000 children participated in Milan Junior Camps worldwide. Since that year, 70 camps have been hosted in the United States and the Caribbean alone.

What are Milan Junior Camps?

- Each camp will be hosted by at least two A.C. Milan certified coaches coming directly from Milan, Italy.
- In some cases, subject to schedule availability, a former great A.C. Milan player will be present at camp for coaching, playing and autographs.
- Each child will receive an official A.C. Milan Junior Camp Adidas Kit and a Milan Jr. Camp diploma at the end of camp.
- The camps' curriculum has been specially designed for each age group by A.C. Milan's expert coaches and doctors. Typically mornings are for technical and tactical skills and afternoons for small sided games.
- Camps are open to boys and girls between the ages of 6 and 17 at all levels including first time players.
- Camp duration is five days from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm each day. Two-week camps are also possible. Camps may be of two weeks duration.

Proposals

The MJC/Clinic includes:

 - Camp completion certificate/diploma

Benefits of Hosting a Milan Junior Camp

A.C. Milan provide our hosts with:

- First class European soccer club.
- Italian Soccer coaches trained by A.C. Milan to teach soccer to youngsters.
- Many years of experience in training youngsters.
- An established curriculum honed by many years of experience.
- Official Adidas uniform for each camper and assistant coach.
- 5,000 flyers suitable for mailing, handing out or bulk mailing if necessary.
- Web based brochure for emailing.
- Banners and flags for the campsite.

Requirements to host a MJC

- One regulation soccer field in excellent condition per 32 campers
- Small sided fields demarcated.
- Goals for small sided games.
- Sufficient training materials such as cones, flags and hoops.
- Clean and proximate bathrooms.
- An office with functioning phone and internet.
- Ideally a room for video presentations to different age groups.
- Parking.
- Abundant drinking water for campers.
- Rest area for campers to have snacks and meals.
- First aid kit.
- Fields and facilities must be inspected by an A.C. Milan representative

Hosts must(when applicable):

Select assistant coaches (1 per 16) for the camp and submit to AC Milan for approval.

Arrange hotel accommodations for Italian coaches, transportation and meals.

Submit uniform requirements with sufficient anticipation.

Provide adequate staff to handle on site registrations, uniform hand outs, lunches for the coaches and general preparation for the camp and clerical matters.

Take and submit general camp pictures, a photographer is desirable for the camper portraits.

AC Milan will provide:

Uniforms for campers.

Uniforms for assistant coaches, Pinnies, Adidas balls, A.C. Milan flags.
